



DECISION COORDINATION MEETING (Revised)
IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW POLICY WITHOUT QUARANTINE AND VOA SERVICES FOR PPLN
STARTING MARCH 7, 2022

1. Following up on the proposal of the Governor of Bali, the Coordinating Minister for Maritime Affairs and Investment of the Republic of Indonesia has held a Coordination Meeting, Friday, March 4, 2022, at 18.00 WITA which was attended by : Minister of Health of the Republic of Indonesia; the Minister of Tourism and Creative Economy of the Republic of Indonesia; the Minister of Transportation of the Republic of Indonesia; Minister of Law and Human Rights of the Republic of Indonesia; Ministry of Foreign Affairs; Head of the Covid-19 Task Force/Head of BNPB; Coordinator and Member of the Covid-19 Task Force Expert Team; Governor of Bali; Bali Police Chief; Commander of Kodam IX/Udayana; and the Tourism Component.
2. After listening to the opinions and support of the meeting participants regarding the pilot implementation of the new policy for Foreign Travel Actors (PPLN). In accordance with the proposal of the Governor of Bali, the Coordination Meeting decided as follows:
 - a. Enforcement of a no-quarantine policy and *Visa On Arrival* (VOA) service for PPLN starting on March 7, 2022.
 - b. Enforcement of a no-quarantine policy for PPLN, only valid through the entrance of Bali, with air and sea travel.
 - c. Application of *Visa On Arrival* (VOA) services for PPLNs who come from 23 countries, namely: 1) Australia; 2) United States of America; 3) English; 4) Germany, 5) Netherlands; 6) French; 7) Oats; 8) Japan; 9) South Korea; 10) Canada; 11) Italy; 12) New Zealand; 13) Turkey; 14) United Arab Emirates; 15) Malaysian; 16) Thailand; 17) Singapore; 18) Brunei Darussalam; 19) Vietnamese; 20) Laos; 21) Myanmar; 22) Cambodia; and 23) Philippines.
 - d. Health requirements for PPLN: 1) complete vaccination/boosphere, 2) Negative PCR Swab test before departure; 3) have proof of paying off a *booking* for a minimum of 4 days in Bali; 4) take a PCR Swab test upon arrival; 5) if the test result is negative, PPLN is allowed to visit all tourist destinations throughout Bali; 6) if the test result is positive, the PPLN is required to undergo isolation at the hotel; 7) specifically for PPLN who are positive, elderly, and have comorbidities, are immediately admitted to the hospital; and 8) on the 3rd day, PPLN is obliged to take the PCR Swab test, and if the test results are negative, on the 4th day they are allowed to travel outside Bali.
 - e. PPLN must still have health insurance that guarantees Covid-19 according to the provisions.
 - f. Revocation of the obligation to have a sponsor/guarantor for e-Visa Tourism requests.
3. In accordance with the direction of the Coordinating Minister for Maritime Affairs and Investment of the Republic of Indonesia, the Governor of Bali is committed to:
 - a. Accelerating *booster* with a minimum target of 30%, strived to be achieved by March 7, 2022.

- b. Increasing vaccination achievements including *booster* for the elderly.
- c. Ensure the availability of regular treatment rooms and adequate ICU care in the Hospital.

- d. For elderly people whose PCR swab test results are positive and have comorbidities, they are required to immediately follow treatment at the hospital.
- e. The tightening of health protocols and the use of the PeduliLindung application in various places.
- f. Increase readiness at I Gusti Ngurah Rai International Airport for PPLN arrivals so that there is no buildup

4 In order to follow up on the decision of the said Coordination Meeting, the Governor of Bali hereby instructs:

- a. Mayors/Regents throughout Bali to immediately accelerate *booster* starting March 5, 2022 for achieve the minimum target of 30% within 7 days at the latest.
- b. vaccination *booster* can be carried out after 3 months of the 2nd vaccination, there is no need to wait for the 6 month deadline.
- c. vaccination acceleration *booster* is carried out on a banjar and community based basis.
- d. To Pangdam IX/Udayana and Kapolda Bali and their ranks to play an active role and facilitate the acceleration of *booster* to the village level
- e. To tourism components and other communities to play an active role and facilitate the implementation of *booster*
- f. To Perbikel.and Babinkamtibmas as well as community leaders to mobilize residents to *booster* vaccinations *Babmsa* take
- . / Districts together with all Puskesmas to carry out accelerated management of *booster* systematic, massive, measurable, and scheduled manner to achieve the minimum target of 30% in all Cities/Regencies in Bali.
- h. The Provincial Government of Bali is responsible for meeting the availability of vaccines and health workers.
- i. Calling on all components of the Balinese community to work together to make the acceleration *booster*
- j. . To all print media, electronic media, social media, and *online* to take an active role in disseminating this instruction.
- k. The achievement and implementation of this commitment is a determining point for the momentum for the recovery of tourism and the economy of Bali.

Astungkara , what is the great hope of the Balinese people and the prayers of all *Krama* Bali, may the recovery of tourism and the Balinese economy be realized soon, *labda work sidaning don.*
